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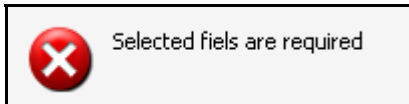


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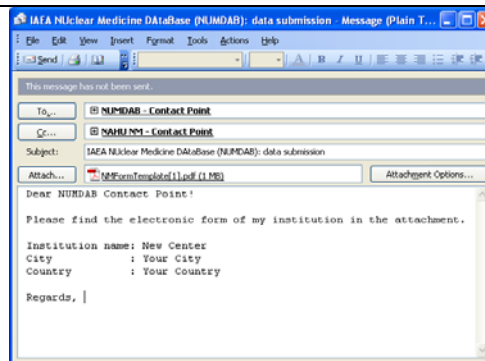
3. Once you click the “EMAIL DATA” button, one of two situations will occur:

a. An error box will appear if either some data is missing, or something was detected as inaccurate. If this happens, simply make appropriate changes, and click the “EMAIL DATA” button again.

For example: fields “City” and “Country” are empty. As the result you will have an error message “Selected fields are required”.



b. If an e-mail field appears, you have entered the data correctly and are ready to proceed



4. In the e-mail field it will NUMDAB@iaea.org in the TO: box, and the .pdf form that you filled out will appear as an attachment. From here you can simply click “SEND”, or, if you wish to type in any comments, you can do so in the text field as in normal e-mails.

Also, if you prefer to use an alternate e-mail (such as yahoo, hotmail, or gmail) to send the form, you can simply choose to save the .pdf document, and attach it manually and send it.
